
The Pilot's Pen – Aviator LED Pen – User Manual

Basic Operation

The Aviator LED Pen uses a 4-way top cap switch. Pressing the top cap performs these functions (remove Cap Protector):

- 1. Extends ink (Light is off)
- 2. Retracts ink (Light is off)
- 3. Extends ink and turns Light ON
- 4. Retracts ink (turns Light Off)

Replacing Ink

- Twist to unscrew and separate the Lower Pen Body from the Upper Pen Body.
- Carefully and slowly separate the two halves.
- Note that the ink cartridge is held inside the lower portion of the Battery Pack Box and rests inside a spring
- Pull the ink cartridge out of the Battery Holder, remove the Ink Cartridge Sleeve and insert a new Ink Cartridge
- Ensure the new Ink Cartridge has the Ink Cartridge Sleeve attached and is placed inside the Lower Pen Body spring
- Put the Battery Holder back inside the Upper Body
- Carefully push the Upper Body and Lower Body back together and screw the halves back together

Replacing Batteries



- Similar to replacing ink (detailed above), separate the Lower Pen Body from the Upper Pen Body
- Remove the Battery Holder and Ink Cartridge Sleeve
- Separate the lower portion of the Battery Holder from the upper portion. Batteries are inside the upper portion
- Replace the individual batteries note the orientation (the "+" side of all batteries is toward the pen switch)
- The replacement battery size is LR44 (see alternative model numbers below). The pen uses Three (3) batteries
- Re-assembly is the reverse process (see Replacing Ink for details)

Replacing Tinted Covers

• Twist to unscrew the Clear tip cover and replace with tinted cover. Tinted covers help preserve night vision.
